

SVdP Naples, since 1977, has been assisting homebound, low-income seniors and disabled neighbors thru our Meals on Wheels program. Today, we operate the largest program in Collier County delivering well over 50,000 meals, annually with a goal of delivering over 82,000 meals come 2024.

The Lenten season focuses us on PRAYER, ALMSGIVING and FASTING

Pope Benedict XVI, Joseph Ratzinger, in his book Jesus of Nazareth writes: "prayer is a way of gradually purifying and correcting our wishes and of slowly coming to realize what we really need: God and His Spirit."

The season of Lent helps me review my relationship with God and to look at what I am asking of Him in prayer. Do I really need what I am asking? Do I humble myself in the presence of God, recognizing my position as a child of God? The prayer of the Our Father, found in the Gospel of Matthew, teaches us how to pray. (Mathew: 6,7-15).
