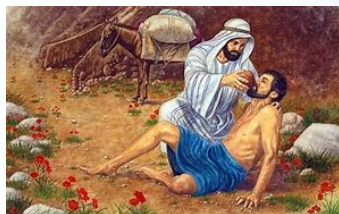

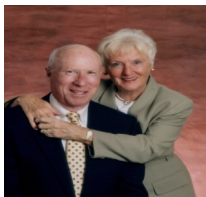

SVdP Naples Receives \$1 Million Gift to Create The McDonagh Family Life Enhancement Program

At the SVdP Naples Donor Appreciation **Breakfast in Paris 1833** (see pg. 2) SVdP Naples Council President John Javaruski, Executive Director Kim



Schul, and Development Director Bill Allen announced the receipt of a \$1 million donation from the estate of Thomas P. & Gloria S. McDonagh. The gift will establish The McDonagh Family Life Enhancement Program.

SVdP Naples provides financial, food, furniture, and other assistance to Collier County working families struggling through a financial crisis. In order to help families avoid future financial struggles, SVdP Naples created the Life Skills Program in 2021. Families can attend free financial literacy, credit management, and employment skills classes; learning how to earn more, spend less, and search for more lucrative employment opportunities.

"While education often leads to higher income levels, many families cannot take time off, quit their jobs, or work part-time to pursue a certificate, degree, or training program that will qualify them for a higher-paying position" said Kim Schul. "We've always wanted to take Life Skills to the next level by creating a program that helps families achieve their dream of financial stability. With this generous gift, we can now offer families The McDonagh Life Enhancement Program."

"The Life Enhancement Program (LEP) will enable Life Skills graduates to partner with SVdP Naples and receive financial assistance (food, rent, utilities, etc.), mentoring, and monitoring while working part-time and completing a certificate, degree or training program. It offers working families the opportunity to enhance their economic, financial, and career trajectory, benefiting the LEP candidate and their entire family. The McDonagh Family's generous gift will improve countless lives in our community" said John Javaruski.

Prior to his passing, Tom McDonagh served as St. William SVdP Conference president and a member of the Naples Board of Directors in the early 2000s.

To qualify for the Life Enhancement Program, individuals and heads of households must successfully complete the SVdP Naples Life Skills Program and be committed to implementing, with SVdP Naples' help, a "personal success plan" that will result in a higher-paying job or position.

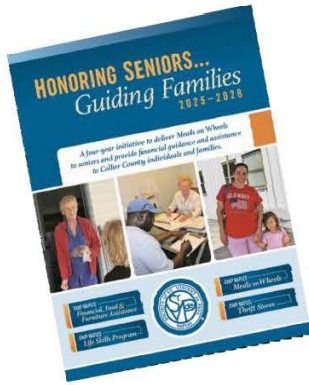

SVdP NAPLES Financial, Food & Furniture Assistance

Financial, Food, and Furniture Assistance:

SVdP Naples turns financial, food (Choice Pantry), and furniture (Thrift Store) donations into life-changing temporary assistance for financially-struggling individuals and families. In FY2023-2024, SVdP Naples provided over \$2.1 million in Financial, Food, and Furniture Assistance directly impacting over 42,100 Collier County seniors, adults, and children.



SVdP NAPLES Meals on Wheels

Meals on Wheels: SVdP Naples operates the largest privately-funded Meals on Wheels operation in Collier County, delivering 60,000 meals in FY2024-2025. SVdP Naples receives no government funding for its Meals on Wheels program. With your help, SVdP Naples will be able to deliver 77,000 meals to homebound seniors and disabled adults by FY2028-2029.

Helping others has been a part of Sylvia Ruiz-Byrne’s DNA since her days as an employee/student at the University of Mount St. Vincent in New York. Sylvia recalls, “One of my mentors was Sister John, a Sister of Charity, an order founded by St. Vincent de Paul, so I was thrilled in 2014 to begin volunteering at the SVdP Naples Thrift Store.”

While working at the Thrift Store, a fellow Vincentian discovered Sylvia’s Spanish-English bilingualism and suggested that Sylvia use that talent to help with casework. Following her move to casework, she soon enlisted her husband, Michael, to join SVdP Naples.

"In the aftermath of Hurricane Irma in 2017, I was recruited to SVdP Naples by Sylvia and Donna Merlin, the then-president of St. Peter’s SVdP Conference, to help with hurricane relief," Michael recounts. Since then the couple has become a dynamic team, conducting home visits and providing assistance to those in need as part of the St. Peter the Apostle SVdP Conference.

Both Sylvia and Michael come from humble beginnings and find their work to be “truly an honor and blessing to be able to help others at this stage of our lives.” When asked, Michael said, “The major issue we face as caseworkers is the magnitude of need here in Naples.” Sylvia adds, “At the same time, it is so rewarding being able to meet and assist so many wonderful and grateful people.”

Sylvia and Michael met on a St. Mary’s (Mount Vernon, NY) parish cruise in 2004, were married in 2008, and moved to Naples in 2014. In addition to their work at SVdP Naples, the couple finds time to enjoy family, friends, travel, golf, tennis, pickleball, and gardening.

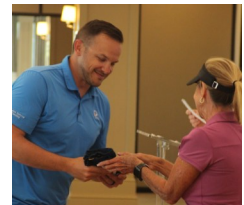
SVdP Naples 2025 Golf Tournament

SVdP Naples Experiencing Record Food Pantry Activity



In April 2025, over 1,600 families visited the SVdP Naples Food Pantry at our Family Assistance Center. SVdP Naples provided over \$136,000 in food assistance to these local families.

Our pantry is a "choice food pantry" allowing our neighbors to receive items that they need and will use, thus, reducing the unnecessary waste of unwanted items.

We offer non-perishable foods and hygiene items, supplemented by milk, eggs, fresh vegetables, and baked goods (when donated).

To streamline operations, SVdP Naples utilizes a Card ID system that creates a faster, more efficient process.
